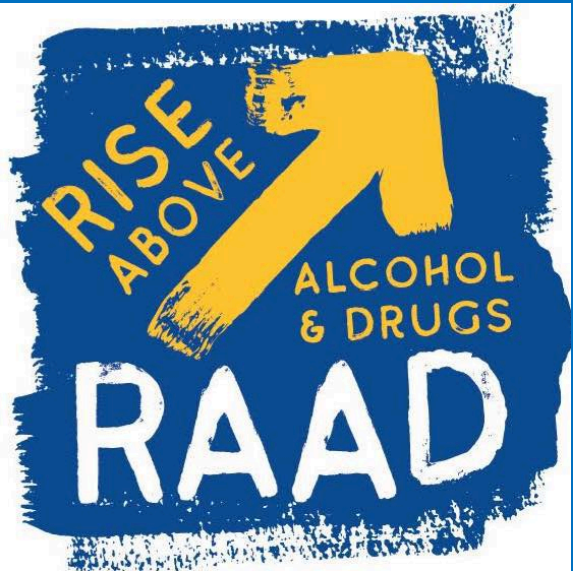

Joyce Raynor, a 2012 recipient of the FBI Director's Community Leadership Award, founded the Women's Council on African American Affairs, Inc., a non-profit organization in 1999. After a series of tragedies to her family, she established the *Center for Healing Hearts and Spirits* and became its Executive Director in January 2002.

The Center provides services to victims and survivors of violent crimes and chronic illness. The Center provides direct services and outreach education to twelve Arkansas Counties.

The Center's programs include Victim Services, Rape Crisis Program, Suicide Prevention, Partnership for Success Drug Prevention Program, Opioid and RX Drugs Abuse Education, Sexual and Domestic Awareness program, Tobacco Prevention and Education, Breast Cancer Awareness, Black on Black Crime Prevention, Youth at Work, Adult and Childhood Obesity Programs, and various Mentoring programs.
